DESCRIPTION

Wizard Forage Oats is the latest release from the leading forage development partnership between The QLD Department of Ag and Heritage Seeds. Wizard presents significant improvement in yield over other forage oats in the market whilst retaining full leaf rust resistance. Wizard has an erect early growth habit, medium plant height, high tillering and fine leaves and stems. Speed to initial grazing is quick, similar to Genie and quicker than Aladdin.

With normal planting time (March – April), Wizard has medium maturity being 5-7 days earlier to anthesis than Genie but 5-7 days later than Volta.

Stem and leaf thickness of Wizard is slightly finer than Genie. It also tends to be higher in tillering and have better recovery from cutting and grazing than Genie.

Wizard will provide growers with a new high yielding, leaf rust resistant, medium / late maturity with excellent recovery in the winter months.


