

Platinum Fine Turf

Golf greens, tees, fairways, bowling greens



PLATINUM FINE TURF is a mixture of perennial ryegrass and red fescue, designed for the construction or overseeding of fine turf under moderate wear pressure.

The "driver" of the mixture is 30% Barolympic perennial ryegrass. Barolympic is the stand-out cultivar ryegrass for summer sports use. It is ranked with a score of 8.7 in Table G4 of BSPB TGS 2021, the highest Mean score in the entire publication, and more than a full point clear of its nearest rival in G4! See Table 1.

In addition to its outstanding Mean score, Barolympic is ranked #1 for pale colour and #2 for fineness of leaf in Table G4. This makes it exceptionally easy to blend in with other grass species, such as red fescue or annual meadowgrass.

The red fescue cultivars Barlineus, Viktorka and Barrisse are exceptional performers, ranked #1, #4 & #3 in their respective tables for close-mown turf.

How to use it	
Sowing rate:	25-35g per m²
Oversowing rate:	15-25g per m²
Sowing depth:	8-12mm below thatch
Mowing height:	Down to 4mm
