Technical Information

Uses

BarRobusto is a regular component of Water Saver Pro and Turf Saver RTF. BarRobusto is great for reducing overall water costs, or increasing turf quality in areas that already have low irrigation budgets. The qualities of BarRobusto are often utilized in golf course roughs, low maintenance sports fields and parks, home lawns, and naturalized no-mow areas.

Establishment

Seeding and establishment may be done in spring or fall, but be weary of summer or winter annuals. For better early weed control, consider an application of Mesotrione in the seeding process. Plant seeds to a depth of no more than 0.25-0.50" below the soil surface to ensure good seed to soil contact. Thatch layers will only slow or impede germination success. After spreading seed, keep seedbed moist throughout germination, with extra care during the early stages to prevent seed from drying out after initial seed imbibition. Germination should begin within 7 to 14 days and be complete within 21 days. The stand should establish in 30 days. Remember, the full turfgrass establishment process may take 6 months to a year.
