

## Kale: Marrow Stem



Kale is a well-proven, highly adaptable fodder crop which consistently provides very high yields of succulent green fodder.

- MARROW STEM is a high yielding marrow stem type kale with clubroot tolerance. Its huge yield makes it ideal for utilisation by dairy and beef cattle.

### Potential

- High-yielding giant type kale with potential yield of 18,000kg DM/ha

### Advantages

- Excellent tolerance to frost
- Good aphid tolerance
- Very high dry matter yields
- Good winter hardiness
- Good clubroot tolerance

100% Marrow Stem Kale

**Sowing rate:** Drilled: 1-2kg/acre (2.5-5kg/ha)

Broadcast: 3kg/acre (7.5kg/ha)

**Pack sizes:** 5kg or 25kg (untreated), 2kg (treated)

### Utilisation:

Graze in situ & Zero Graze

### Sowing period:

Spring & Early Summer

### Utilisation period:

Autumn & Winter

### Days to Maturity:

170-220 days
