

# Medal

## Golf greens, tees, fairways, bowling greens, Cricket, Tennis

### Usage

Overseeding, divotting and/or construction of medium-fine and fine turf with high wear; golf and bowling greens; tees and fairways

### Key points

- Barolympic #1 Table G4 8.6!
- Barsignum #2 Visual Merit Table L1; ranked #5 on L1 and #4 G4

### Species Formulation

60% perennial ryegrass  
40% slender creeping red fescue



**MEDAL is a mixture of perennial ryegrass and red fescue, designed for the construction or overseeding of medium-fine and fine turf under high wear pressure.**

The main components of the mixture are the ryegrasses; Barolympic and Barsignum. Barolympic is the stand-out cultivar ryegrass for summer sports use. It is ranked #1 with a score of 8.6 in Table G4 of BSPB TGS 2019, the highest Mean score in the entire publication, and more than a full point clear of its nearest rival in G4! See Table 1. Barsignum is an outstanding ryegrass in its own right, ranked #5 in Tables L1 and #4 in G4.

Inclusion of 40% slender and strong creeping red fescues improves shoot density and aesthetics. Barrisse exhibits excellent resistance to red thread.

### IN THE BAG

- 30% **Barolympic** perennial ryegrass
- 30% **Barsignum** perennial ryegrass
- 20% **Finesto** slender creeping red fescue
- 20% **Barrisse** strong creeping red fescue

- Sowing rate:** 20-35g/m<sup>2</sup>
- Oversowing rate:** 15-25g/m<sup>2</sup>
- Sowing depth:** 8-12mm below thatch
- Mowing height:** Down to 4mm
- Pack size:** 20kg
