

Common bent is the most widely used grass seed species in the renovation of golf greens in the UK. Bent is found growing in free-draining sand greens, through to moisture retentive soil based greens. The small seed size means that it can be easily sown into an existing green without causing significant disturbance to the surface.

- Affordable option for the renovation of golf and bowling greens
- Small seed size makes it ideal for overseeding without major disruption to playing surfaces
- Key constituent species of greens throughout the UK Tolerant of close mowing down to 4mm
- Uses varieties tested by the Sports Turf Research Institute

(Please note that bent seed is exceptionally small, consequently the sowing rate is much lower than other grass seed mixtures.)
