SEEDING AND MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

SEEDING RATE:

▶ Overseeding Existing Turf 2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.
▶ Sports turf
▶ Tees and Fairways 3 to 5 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.
Lawns, Parks & Other Areas 3 to 5 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.
▶ Sod Production

- ▶ FERTILIZATION: For optimum results apply .50 to .75 lbs. of N/1,000 sq. ft. per application during the growing season. Requires 4 to 8 lbs. of N/1,000 sq. ft. per year. Rates may vary due to geographical differences and agronomic preferences.
