### Technical Information

#### Applications

Beyond is an elite Kentucky bluegrass that will perform beautifully across a range of climates and management regimes - from golf courses in the transition zone to athletic fields in the cold Northern regions. Beyond can tolerate mowing heights from .5 in. to 3 or more, but performs best between .5 and 2 in.

#### Specifications

Beyond performs well by itself, or in blends with other Jacklin Kentucky bluegrasses. Beyond is also a great choice for mixing with Jacklin perennial ryegrasses and tall fescues. We recommend mixing Beyond with 20% ryegrass or 80% tall fescue.
