#### **DESCRIPTION**

Bargusto is a new Bermudagrass variety recently released from Barenbrug's Warm Season Turfgrass Breeding Program. Bargusto exhibits high summer turf quality with excellent early spring growth. Uniform leaf texture and its ability to establish very quickly, makes it an ideal choice for a number of applications including home lawns, sports fields and reclamation requirements.

Bargusto is an improved seeded variety of Bermudagrass. 'Improved' Bermudagrass types are mostly seeded varieties and are darker green, deeper rooted, medium textured and denser compared to common Bermudagrass.

## BERMUDAGRASS/COUCH (Cynodon dactylon)

Bermudagrass produces a vigorous, deep-rooted and medium green, dense turf which is well adapted to most soils and grows the best in warm climates. Bermudagrass spreads by both rhizomes and stolons. It has excellent wear, drought, heat and salt tolerance, establishes quickly, produces lateral stems and is competitive against weeds.

### RECOMMENDED SOWING RATE

Sowing rate: 1 kg per 100m<sup>2</sup>

Bermudagrass should be sown into > 18 degree soil temperatures and covered with 3-5mm of soil. It is important with warm season grasses to keep the soil moist while the seed is germinating. In warmer climates, during the first 7-10 days, it may be necessary to water for short periods several times daily.
