PLANT CHARACTERISTICS

Bengal Creeping Bentgrass is a dense, low-thatch producing, drought tolerant plant that exhibits excellent turf quality on greens, tees, and fairways. Leaf texture is fine, upright and retains color throughout the fall and winter while excelling at spring green-up. Built-in resistance to Brown Patch, Downy Mildew, and Dollar Spot.

SEEDING RATES

For new plantings seed Bengal Creeping Bentgrass at 1 to 2 pounds per 1,000 square feet or 45 to 85 pounds per acre. Overseed at 1/2 pound per 1,000 square feet or 25 pounds per acre.

FERTILIZATION

Bengal Creeping Bentgrass requires 1/2 pound actual nitrogen per 1,000 square feet per application in most areas of the United States. Bengal exhibits excellent performance at more than 6 pounds of nitrogen per year.

MOWING HEIGHT

Bengal Creeping Bentgrass requires frequent mowing and should be mowed at a low height. Recommended mowing heights are:

Greens: 1/8" to 1/4" Tees: 1/4" to 3/8" Fairways: 3/8" to 1/2"

WATERING

After establishment Bengal Creeping Bentgrass prefers deep watering early in the morning.
